NEW FOR 2015 FREE GAA GEAR AND BACKPACK

WHAT DO CHILDREN DO AT KELLOGG'S GAA CÚL CAMPS?

- On the last day of the camp a "blitz" will be organised to provide each child with an introduction to competitive games.
